

CHPP Required Course List



Certified Homeland Protection Professional (CHPP) Required Course List

In addition to the educational and experience requirements, the Certified Protection Professional (CHPP) applicants must submit documentation of the minimum required course work in each of the following subjects:

- 16 hours - Threat, Risk, and Vulnerability Assessment
- 8 hours - CBRNE/Weapons of Mass Destruction
- 8 hours - Incident Management

The following course work will be automatically accepted toward the required hours of course work:

1. The National Sheriff's Association Weapons of First Responder course will satisfy:
 - 8 hours of Threat, Risk, and Vulnerability
 - 8 hours of CBRNE/WMD
 - 8 hours of Incident Management
2. The National Domestic Preparedness Coalition's OpValTRVA, HLS-CAM, or Vulnerability Assessment courses will satisfy:
 - 16 hours Threat, Risk, and Vulnerability Assessments
3. All DHS/FEMA courses in the subject areas will be accepted.
4. Academy credits in related subject matter will be accepted.
5. Courses will be evaluated on a case by case basis.
6. If the course certificate does not contain the contact hours you must supply the supporting documentation to indicate the contact hours.
