Dr. Ross Wolf is Associate Dean in the College of Health and Public Affairs and Associate Professor in the Department of Criminal Justice at the University of Central Florida. He was appointed to and serves on the International Association of Chiefs of Police (IACP) Police Administration Committee, and on the National Sheriffs' Association (NSA) Outreach Committee. He was awarded the United States Presidential "Daily Point of Light" Award in 2014, the National Sheriffs' Association "Medal of Merit" in 2014, and the Presidential "Lifetime Call to Service Award" in 2006 for his work with volunteer and reserve policing.

He has co-authored three course textbooks on police interviewing and over twenty refereed articles and book chapters on campus law enforcement, police administration and management, reserve and volunteer policing, police use of force, tourism policing, and international policing. In addition to his work with police agencies throughout the United States, he has worked with the police in the Caribbean, the United Kingdom, Russia, Hong Kong, and Singapore.
