BIOGRAPHY

Donald Jordan has over 27 years military and DoD experience in Airborne Infantry, Personnel Recovery and Force Protection Operations. Mr. Jordan is a recognized Antiterrorism, Force Protection and Physical Security professional. He has deployed to Operation Desert Storm, Operation Iraqi Freedom, Operation Enduring Freedom and Multinational Force and Observers, Sinai Egypt. Mr. Jordan has also been stationed on the South Korean DMZ and Germany two tours each. Mr. Jordan was a Personnel Recovery Team Leader in the only dedicated over-water and overland aviation company in the U.S. Army. Mr. Jordan assisted with the training of 3 combat search and rescue teams (CSAR) which was responsible for theater Personnel Recovery Operations.

Mr. Jordan performed duties as a Protection Operations Specialist, for USACE, South Atlantic Division. Responsible for 5 Districts and over 3000 personnel. The Operational Protection Division (OPD) serves as the primary advisor to the USACE Commanding General for protection. Provides policy and support to USACE organizations for the functional areas of Antiterrorism (AT), Physical Security (PS), and Law Enforcement (LE) and Criminal Intelligence (CRIMINT). In support of the Director of Contingency Operations, coordinates and synchronizes the functional areas of protection in order to maximize the security of the USACE workforce, infrastructure, and information in a risk-informed manner.

Mr. Jordan was forward deployed as a Field Service Representative in Afghanistan, supporting C4 ISR in support of DOD Special Operations Forces, U.S. Army and other Government Agencies. Responsible for monitoring and gathering intelligence information from measurement and signature intelligence data sets and to prepare findings to formulate Counter IED analysis which can be utilized in making life saving decisions. This information was used to plan and conduct potential High Value Target direct action operations against insurgent networks.

Mr. Jordan is the current chairman of the Anti- Terrorism Accreditation Board's Military Committee. A former member of the ASIS Chief Security Officer Technical Committee, ASIS Security Services Council and The American Board for Certification in Homeland Security Aviation Board. Mr. Jordan in his current position is the Antiterrorism Officer, Program Coordinator for the Arkansas National Guard.
